You're also invited to come to **Wednesday Advent services**:

This will also be a time for fellowship, and will take place in the Fellowship Hall. The offering basket on the counter during fellowship time will benefit important missions.
- ❖ ***Worship*** will be our normal time: **7:00 PM** in the Sanctuary. This year's theme for our reflections will be: *Sing We Now of Christmas!* We will hear the background of three different Advent or Christmas hymns, after which we'll sing those hymns. Members of the Worship Committee are preparing these reflections.
